Social Enterprise for Canadian Charities: Legal Compliance from A-Z

Charities are under increasing pressure to increase and diversify revenue. At the same time social enterprise offers a method to tackle complex social and economic problems. In this full day workshop charity lawyers Mark Blumberg (www.canadiancharitylaw.ca) and Richard Bridge (www.lawyerforcharities.ca) will cover the top 15 key legal issues facing charities in the morning and in the afternoon, specific legal issues affecting charities that wish to be involved with business activities, earned income, social enterprise, community economic development and fundraising. There are many advantages of being a charity and also many restrictions and responsibilities. It is important that Canadian charities comply with their legal responsibilities or the consequences in terms of reputation, charitable status and assets can be substantial.

Who should attend these workshops: Executive Directors, Board Chairs, Treasurers, Senior Managers, Fundraisers and Program officers. NB - These presentations are suitable for both staff and/or volunteers of registered charities to attend.
